Shenandoah Van Transportation Update

The Clarinda Lutheran school board has been reviewing the usage of the van that transports students to and from school. After the careful evaluation of finances, insurance policies, and best practices for the school, it has been determined to formally state and clarify the "Shenandoah van" services. Here is the preliminary draft that has been approved by the school board:

"The Clarinda Lutheran van will follow a route determined by the school board that is the most effective path from the driver's residence to the school building. If a student/family is not on the designated route, Trinity Lutheran Church will be the pick-up and drop off location. Times for pick up and drop off at Trinity Lutheran Church will be set by the school board and may vary pending weather conditions.

*Reasoning for changes of the 2021-2022 academic year, the Clarinda Lutheran van shall efficiently run a transportation service for students that maintains minimal wear on the vehicle, limited gas expenses, and proficient use of the driver's (volunteer's) time.
